PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

LHI will train 160 students in a period of 1 year computer basic programs such as: Microsoft Word, Excel Power Point, Access and Internet Explorer. A cycle will be trained within a period of 3 months.

PROBLEM STATEMENT:

a. The problem to be addressed: Lack of Professional skills

It is very hard for refugees to find jobs in asylum country because even though they are educated but the documents (Diploma / certificates) are not eligible while applying for jobs. The language barrier also becomes a big problem. For example a big number of refugees in Uganda come from Democratic Republic of Congo which is Francophone based educational System, different from Uganda which is Anglophone educational system.

All the people can't also be employed as the positions are limited to some numbers, which also cause a jobless situation, hence increase of poverty, prostitution, early pregnancies and marriages, banditism, drug abuse and many other organized crimes.

b. How our project address the problem

LHI provides machinery and materials for vocational training. This enables the youths to find employment or start their own business for self reliance hence craft the successful future for themselves as our vision states.
