PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

LHI identified at least seventy (70) most vulnerable refugee children, and It will have them registered in neighboring schools, Pay the school fees and provide other scholastic materials; and lastly, follow up, and psychosocial support where needed for a period of 7 years.

PROBLEM STATEMENT:

a. Understanding the Problem:

School dropping reasons differ depending to individual circumstances. Most girls' cases appeared to be early pregnancies and marriages as well as prostitution.

In contrast, their drop out brothers, face hard life conditions in the refugee camp, because they have no required educational qualifications for the job **which finally leads to organized crimes, drug abuse, and producing a poor generation hence a burden to the community, country and the world.**

b. **The problem to be addressed:** Lack of Education for Refugee vulnerable Children

- *Uganda hosts one of the biggest percentages of refugees in the world and more continue to arrive. Many have experienced extreme violence.*
- *They have been welcomed into some of the poorest parts of the country, putting further strain on already limited resources in host communities.*
- *Yet, most children are not getting the education they deserve:*
- *1.3 MILLION REFUGEES*
- *60% ARE CHILDREN*
- *601,799 CHILDREN STILL OUT OF SCHOOL*
