Digital Skills Empowerment to Local Organizations

With this, LHI is empowering local organizations by starting with 90 women representatives from different organizations in Kyaka. LHI launched the “Digital Empowerment for Refugee Women-led Businesses” project funded by UNHCR through UNHCR Innovation Services. This initiative aims to bridge the digital gender divide and foster economic growth among refugee women-led organizations by addressing challenges like limited market access, lack of ICT skills and resource mobilization.

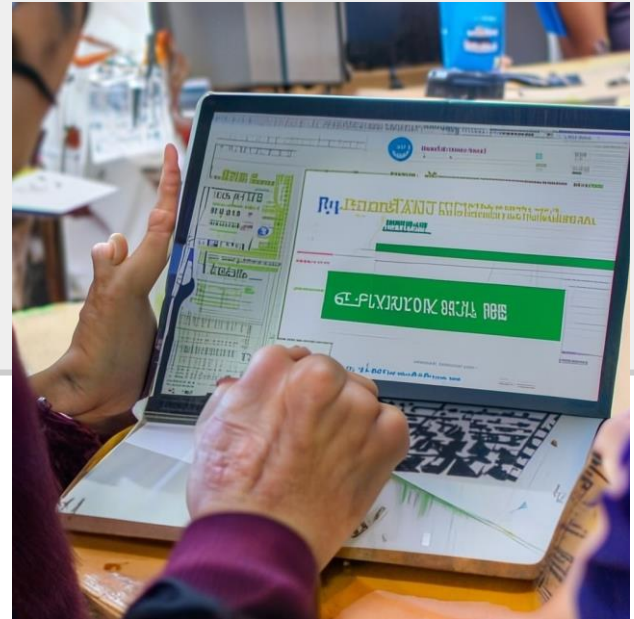

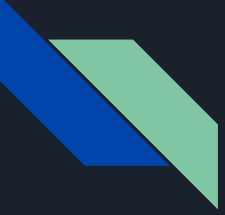
